HELP US FIND DESCENDANTS

Is your ancestor buried at the Westtown Shiloh AME Church cemetery? We'd like to hear from you.

In the early 1920s, Shiloh AME Church and cemetery was located at Little Shiloh and Shiloh roads, Westtown Township. It closed its doors due to a shrinking congregation and was demolished in the 1960s.

The adjacent cemetery had an estimated 140 burials, including 14 U.S. Colored Troops — heroic Civil War veterans. The Friends of Shiloh AME Church and Cemetery, an organization of interested residents formed in 2023, are trying to gain access and preserve the half-acre of ground that held this once vibrant congregation.

We are looking for descendants of those buried at Shiloh. If you have an ancestor buried there, think you may, or have related information or questions, please contact Shilohamefriends@gmail.com.
