GOVERNMENT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE PURSUANT TO <u>TITLE 18, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 3161(h)(7)(A)</u>

The United States of America, by and through its attorneys, David Metcalf,
United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and Everett Witherell, Assistant
United States Attorney, moves for a thirty-day continuance of the time within which an Indictment or Information must be filed in this case, and in support of this motion states as follows:

- 1. On October 21, 2025, a Complaint was filed by the United States
 Attorney's Office charging defendant Kevin Krebs with unlawful making and possession of
 unregistered destructive devices, in violation of Title 26, United States Code, Section 5861(d),
 (f) and Section 5871.
- 2. On October 23, 2025, the defendant made his initial appearance on the Complaint.
- 3. The Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3161 et seq., requires that an Indictment or Information be filed within thirty days from the date on which the defendant made his initial appearance, in this case by November 22, 2025. 18 U.S.C. § 3161(b).
- 4. The government and the defendant are engaging in discussions to resolve this matter through a non-trial disposition.

5. Counsel for the defendant has represented that the defendant does not oppose the government's request for a thirty-day continuance.

WHEREFORE, for the above reasons, it is respectfully submitted that the ends of justice will be served best by the granting of a continuance of thirty days of the time within which to file an Indictment or Information in this case, that is, until December 22, 2025.
