Dear Ms. Ferris:

This letter concerns the above-referenced FOIA request, received by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA or Agency) on April 27, 2026, in which you requested various records regarding Sentinel Green Fig, LCC or any representative of the company concerning the Foote Mineral Superfund Site in East Whiteland Township, Pennsylvania. On June 1 and July 8, 2026, we provided you with interim responses to your request. You will find additional records responsive to your request being released as a third interim response by visiting the FOIAXpress Public Access Link at <https://foiapublicaccessportal.epa.gov>.

The EPA has considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing records and applying FOIA exemptions. We are releasing four records to you in full and seven records are being withheld in part pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6), which permits the withholding of information involving matters of personal privacy protected under the Privacy Act or containing sensitive personally identifiable information.

Your request remains open at this time. When your request is closed you will receive information regarding your appeal rights for any part of the EPA's response.
